## Abilene Woman's Burial Planned at Hereford

Funeral services for Mrs. W. R. Matthews, 81, of 1026 Grape St. will be held in Hereford, probably Sunday.

Mrs. Matthews died at 4 am. Friday at her home here after a year's illness.

The body was to be taken to Hereford Friday night in a Kiker-Warren Funeral Home coach. Burial will be In Hereford.

She was born Sarah Virginia Ethridge Nov. 21, 1869 in Columbia County, Ark. She was married to W. R. Matthews, Feb. 2, 1888 in Romance, Arkansas.

The couple moved to Eastland County in 1906 from Arkansas. In 1924 they moved to Hereford, where Mr. Matthews died in 1945. Mrs. Matthews came to Abilene in September of 1948.

Survivors include three sons, W.J. Matthews, of Eastland, S.T. Matthews of Abilene, and L. J. Matthews of Hereford; and one daughter, Miss Odie Matthews of Abilene.
