

Adkins, Mrs. Sallie Hart, (widow of Rev. Aaron Adkins), early resident of McDuffie County, born June 19, 1798, Warren County, Georgia, died April 13, 1872, McDuffie County, Georgia. Daughter of Isaac and Polly (Newsome) Hart. Both Hart and Newsome families from Virginia.

Her husband, Aaron Adkins, born August 24, 1795, Warren County, Georgia, died May 20, 1865, Warren County, Georgia (now McDuffie County). When McDuffie county was formed it embraced the Adkins home.

Among the earliest settlers of land that is now included in McDuffie county was the parents of Aaron Adkins; Daniel Adkins from Williamsburg, Va. and his wife Penelope Tyson of Petersburg, Virginia. They came with others about 1770 and got head-right grant of 300 acres in Briar Creek neighborhood in lower part of what is now McDuffie County, and established a home.
