

Mrs. Ethridge Dies In Ardmore

Funeral Services Are to Be Held at Emmanuel Baptist Church

Services are to be conducted Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from the Emmanuel Baptist church for Mrs. M.J. Ethridge, who died Friday night at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. Iley Oxford, with whom she lived.

Rev. Maurice A. Cook will officiate at the funeral to be followed by burial at Rose Hill cemetery under direction of Harvey Bros.

Bearers for the body announced by the family are to include Jack Hays, J.R. Oxford, C.R. Johnson, C.H. Williams, J.L. Harlan and H.L. Ledbetter.

Mrs. Ethridge was born Sept. 30, 1849, in Columbia county, Arkansas. She became identified with the Baptist church when 15 years old and lived a consecrated Christian life, friends said Saturday. She was a member of the Emmanuel Baptist church.
