### A E. Hart

- Mr. Augustus E. Hart, who died at Rev. J. W. Tennison's residence four miles north of Lampasas, on Monday, May 2nd, 1904, was born near Americus, Georgia, 56 years ago, where he grew to manhood, and married Miss Jane Black, an accomplished lady, who died ten years since.
- Seven years ago he married Mrs. Lottie Grimes, of Lampasas, who was a most faithful companion and a true wife to him. She mourns his death, and we extend our sympathy to her in her sad bereavement.
- Four children surviving Mr. Hart are Allen Hart, machinist, Denison, Texas, Mrs. Nora Simmons of Denison, Texas, Mr. Lee Hart, locomotive engineer of Denison, Texas: Mrs. J. W. Tennison, of Lampasas.
- Mr. Hart was a true husband, an indulgent father, a kind neighbor, a man of broad and liberal views on religion and public affairs. He possessed more than a common education and had an amiable and pleasing manner.
- Mr. Hart resided for many years on the Lampasas river, where everyone was his friend. He moved some years ago to Denison, Texas where he sustained an injury in an accident some 12 months ago, his health failed as a consequence, and he fell a prey to the dreaded consumption, from which he suffered all the tortures incident. He bore it with patient fortitude until God in His mercy eased his pains. Lost from home, a husband; children miss a father's love, neighbors have one friend less. God took from his poor, painracked, emaciated form a brilliant mind or soul, to adopt in His kingdom above.
