

Man Injured Twice While at His Work Dies in Hospital

Arthur C. Pierce, lineman for the Albuquerque Gas and Electric Co., and president of the electrical union, Local No. 611, died in a hospital here Wednesday afternoon.

Pierce was burned by a "hot" wire several days ago, and was released from the hospital on May 29. Two days later, while riding on top of the company's truck, he fell off and suffered a broken leg and other injuries.

He is survived by his wife, a son, Marron, three sisters, and a brother. The Strong-Thorne Mortuary will announce funeral arrangements.
