

Obituary

Meddie Cleveland Ethridge was born Sept. 27, 1885 in Romance, Arkansas. The son of Rev. and Mrs. S.J. Ethridge. The family went to Texas in 1859 and moved to Oklahoma and settled at Woodford in 1892. In 1901, Rev. Ethridge homesteaded west of Frederick. He remained on his claim until 1905 when he went to Centrahoma where he preached until 1907 where he was stricken and died. After his father's death, Mr. Ethridge moved to Melrose, N.M. where he homesteaded a claim. He was united in marriage with Salley Leola Frost July 10, 1909. To this union, 8 children were born, seven survive; Mrs. Clyde Mort of Jarosa, Colo., Velma Dee, William, M.C. and Donald of Waterloo, Mrs. J.M. McClure of Visalia, Calif, and Alma of Yukon, Okla.

He went to California for about three years and then returned to Waterloo in 1919, where he remained until his death.

Funeral services were held at the Waterloo Nazarene church, Wednesday, at 2 p.m. Rev. Hill of Oklahoma City officiating.

Interment was at the Waterloo cemetery. Paas Funeral directors were in charge of arrangements.
