J. M. Carter, Lawyer, Dies

J. M. Carter, 62, 1720 Fairmount Avenue, prominent in West Texas legal circles for many years, died at 3:40 p.m. yesterday in a hospital after an operation. He had been ill since last November.

He entered the practice of law in Stephenville, where he married Miss Fannie Hale. Several years later they moved with their two daughters, Christine and Hazel, to Aspermont, Stonewall County, where Carter was elected to the district court bench.

Carter established his residence in Fort Worth 14 years ago, continuing the practice of his profession.

Funeral arrangements are pending the arrival here today of a daughter, Mrs. C. A. Love, Denver, Colo. Others surviving are his wife, the second daughter, Mrs. Wesley Ammerman Jr., Fort Worth: a sister, Mrs. Emma Vinson, Hico, and four brothers, Nolan Carter, Colorado, Texas; James and Jack Carter of Eastland and Oscar Carter, whose present address is not known.

The body is at the Harveson & Cole Funeral Home.
